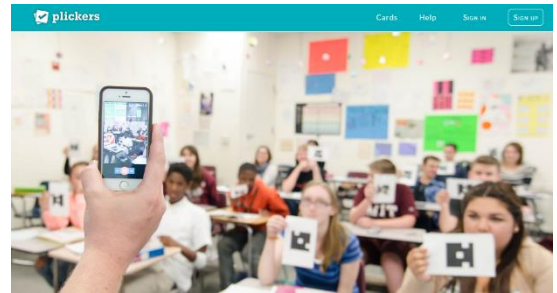


TEACHMEET – FRIDAY 17TH MARCH 2017

Discussion of apps that can be used for assessment, quizzing and feedback, irrespective of the device pupils bring to class. Promotes AfL practice and low-stakes testing.

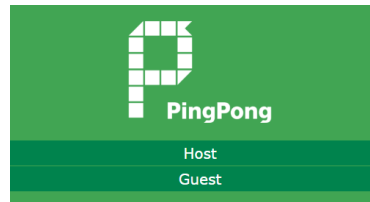
1. **Plickers** – pupils do not require a device. Response cards can be laminated and assigned to a pupil (they always use their card and store it in their file). Quizzes can be constructed very quickly, even within the lesson as pupils work on a task. A great app for plenaries. Data can be downloaded and stored.

2. **PingPong** – fantastic whole class response tool. Images, text, MCQs, true/false answers are possible. Works on basis of verbal question from teacher and electronic response from pupils – rather like an electronic version of a 'ShowMe' board.

3. **Kahoot** – quizzing app. Fast-paced and competitive. Students can use any device to submit their responses, no sign in or app download required. Very easy to construct questions – pupils can do it and generate class quizzes: effective part of flipped learning or pupil-led seminar lessons. Images and videos can be included – this allows for 'blind kahooting' (teaching a topic through questions) rather than solely using in the traditional assessment way.

4. **Go Soapbox** – generates a virtual space for pupils and teacher to communicate within the classroom. Polls, quizzes and discussion forum available. The app also contains a confusion measure so pupils can indicate when they do not understand something. In all a great app for those that are less confident in speaking out in class – they can submit ideas / thoughts / questions electronically.

5. **Quizlet** – electronic cue cards. Brilliant for revision and testing key vocab. Teacher or pupil enters key terms and definitions. The app generates quizzes, mix and match, sorting tasks and more... A great tool for flexible and active revision.
